## WHERE ARE YOU BASED AND WHAT FACILITIES DO YOU HAVE?

*I have a purpose built waxing studio at my home in Bonnyrigg, Midlothian. Toilet facilities are available.*

## IS PARKING AVAILABLE?

*Visitor parking is available, please do not park in spaces that are numbered.*

## HOW SHOULD I PREPARE FOR MY APPOINTMENT?

*Gentle exfoliation prior to your appointment will help remove any dead skin cells, this will allow better results. Please shower on the day of your appointment and it is advised to come to your appointment wearing loose and comfortable clothing.*

## IS THERE ANYTHING I SHOULD AVOID PRIOR TO MY APPOINTMENT?

*Please avoid sunbathing, sunbeds and any chemical exfoliants (AHAs or BHAs products).*

## HOW LONG DOES THE HAIR NEED TO BE?

*If you have been shaving or waxing, leave it at least 4 weeks before your appointment. This will ensure the best results are achieved.*

## WILL I NEED TO REMOVE MY UNDERWEAR?

*For Hollywood, Brazilian and G-string waxing you will be asked to remove your underwear. For bikini waxing disposable underwear will be provided.*

## CAN I BE WAXED WHILST ON MY PERIOD?

*Absolutely, as long as you wear a clean tampon to your appointment.*

## I'M PREGNANT, CAN I BE WAXED?

*Certainly, waxing in pregnancy is completely safe. A pregnancy pillow will be provided to ensure maximum comfort.*

## WHAT AFTER-CARE SHOULD I UNDERTAKE?

*For the next 24-48 hours, please keep the area clean, avoid hot baths/showers (lukewarm water only), avoid saunas/steam treatments/hot tubs and do not undertake any tanning (fake, sunbed or sunbathing).*

## HOW DO I AVOID INGROWN HAIRS?

*Regular exfoliation is the key to preventing ingrown hairs. I am an official stockist for "Ruff Stuff" body scrub. A holy grail for ingrown hairs!
